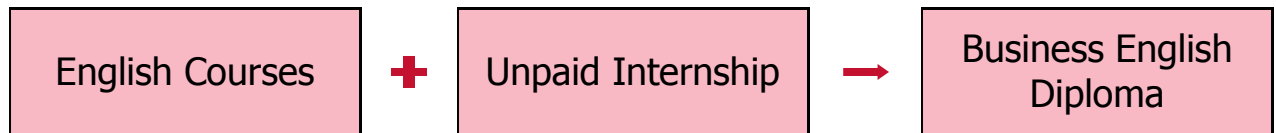

Program Notes

- The Internship component must be equal to or less than the duration of the English component
- Students must achieve a minimum of Eurocentres Level 5 prior to the start of the Internship (may be higher depending on field)
- Students must be high school graduates and 18 years of age at the time the course starts
- Students must complete an internship form indicating three areas of interest, and submit a résumé (CV) in English along with application
- Students enrolled in a course longer than 6 months must obtain a Study Permit prior to coming to Canada and will need to apply for a Work Permit after arriving in Canada
- The Internship Placement Fee includes:
 - Guaranteed placement in an internship in one of your 3 areas of interest (based on your previous work experience)
 - Consulting on résumé writing and interview techniques
 - Bi-weekly monitoring and counseling during internship
