Program Features

English Lessons

Students have 20 lessons of English per week to improve their everyday English fluency. These morning lessons focus on the development of communicative skills in a wide variety of situations. First day and regular evaluations ensure that every student progresses at an appropriate pace. Classes are held at either UBC or Ryerson University. Towards the end of summer, classes may be held at the Toronto and Vancouver downtown campuses.

Afternoon Activities

On weekday afternoons, students take part in a range of recreational, cultural and sightseeing activities, both on and off campus. In Vancouver, activities may include swimming, soccer or beach volleyball, as well as trips to Stanley Park, Granville Island, Capilano Suspension Bridge, Metrotown, the Vancouver Aquarium and Kitsilano Beach. In Toronto, activities may include visiting the CN Tower, Centre Island, Ontario Place, the Royal Ontario Museum, Laser Tag, beaches, biking tours, canoe adventures, swimming and a trip to the Science Centre.

Weekend Activities

Weekend activities are also central to the program. Students participate in full day off-campus activities, enabling them to get the most out of their stay. Weekend activities in Vancouver may include visits to Grouse Mountain, Whistler Resort, Victoria, Playland Amusement Park and Seymour Demonstration Forest. Toronto On-Campus activities may include visits to Niagara Falls, Algonquin Park, Harbourfront Festival, Canada's Wonderland, Metro Toronto Zoo and a beach picnic.

Evening Activities

(On-Campus Residence Students Only) Students in residence accommodations participate in exciting and fun evening activities. Sample evening activities in Vancouver include movie night, fireworks, Pacific Spirit Park, Jericho Beach, volleyball tournament and games night.

In Toronto, these activities may include fireworks, movies, volleyball, soccer, Blue Jays baseball, street festivals and Centre Island/Ward's Island.

Staff and Instructors

Eurocentres Canada has carefully selected professional staff and teachers who are qualified, experienced and enthusiastic about helping each student. All of our instructors have degrees from recognized universities, as well as qualifications and experience in teaching English as a Second Language to students from different language backgrounds. Our teachers strive to help students improve their English quickly and effectively, while ensuring they experience exciting and fun activities. Eurocentres Canada staff are dedicated to ensuring that all students are happy, well cared-for and safe.

Airport Transfers

Airport pick-up and drop-off services provide students with a safe and friendly arrival and departure to and from Canada.

School Transportation

Students with homestay accommodations are provided with transit tickets (or the school will arrange alternative transportation) to travel to and from school on their own. Students under the age of 13 years must be accompanied to and from school by a responsible adult, for which there is an additional fee of \$25 per day. Supervised transportation is also available to students 13+ as an optional service for the same fee.

Residence

(University of British Columbia & Ryerson University)

UBC and Ryerson University residences provide superb on-campus accommodations for students who want to experience the Canadian university lifestyle. Students have a private or twin room with shared washroom facilities located on each floor. A Eurocentres Canada staff member lives with the students in the residence to ensure that they have 24-hour supervision. Three well-balanced meals (bag lunch) are provided daily through the university's catering service.

Homestay

Our on-staff Accommodations Coordinator carefully selects all host families. The program is meticulously monitored to guarantee that students have positive homestay experiences with excellent Canadian families. Students have their own private room (unless otherwise requested) and are provided with 3 well-balanced meals (bag lunch) per day by the host family.

Safety & Supervision

We are extremely selective in choosing the accommodations, facilities and staff to make sure that everyone has a safe, successful and rewarding experience. We ensure that 24-hour supervision is provided to all students in residence and to students under 13 years of age in homestay.
