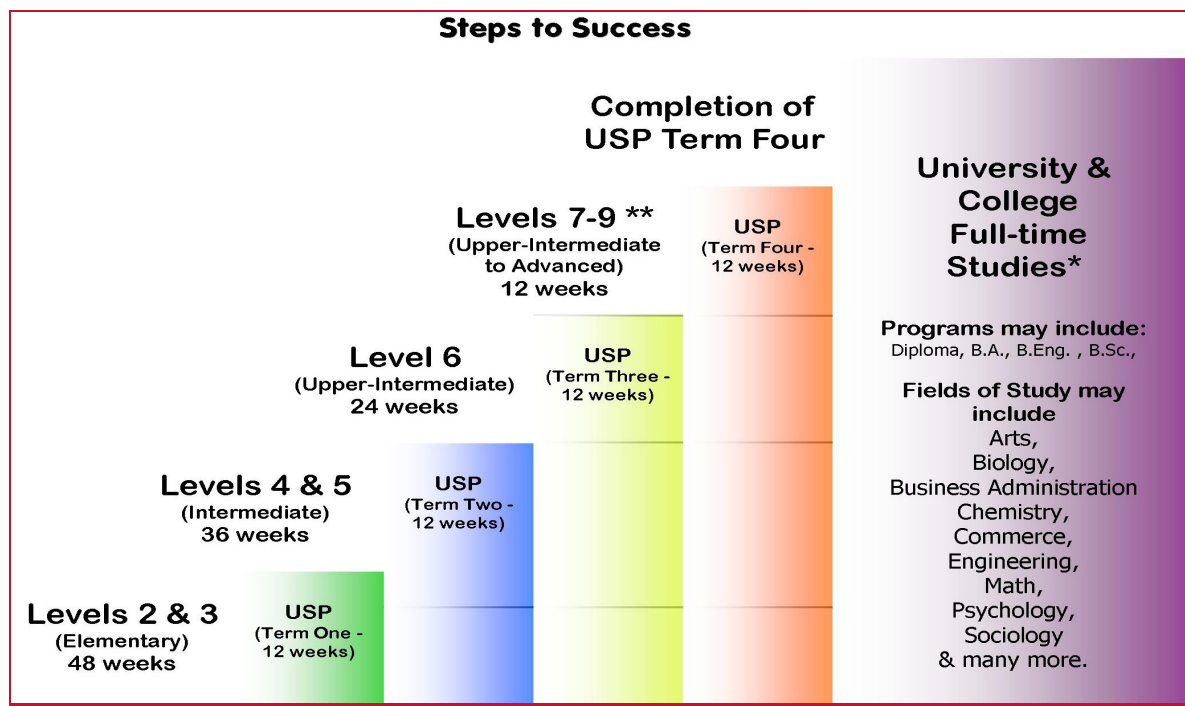

The purpose of the program is to provide a solid foundation for English language skills specializing in English for Academic Purposes. Students will learn the skills necessary for academic success by studying and practicing English as it is used in context with an emphasis on improving their vocabulary. There is a strong emphasis on building up register, language repertoire and usage, while helping students to recognize and correct their own mistakes. Daily speaking practice is given and written skills are developed systematically with an emphasis on academic writing.



Students enrolling in the Pathway Program will have 48, 36, 24 or 12 weeks of English language training in our Specialized Super-Intensive Course followed by their Post-secondary program.

Qualifications

Minimum exit level

Students must meet the Eurocentres Scale of Proficiency Exit Level 8 prior to their transfer to university / college. Students who fail to meet the required Eurocentres Scale of Proficiency Level may be required to take additional weeks of language study.

Minimum age

Applicants must be 18 years of age and high school graduates at the time of the application.

Language ability

Students must have a minimum Level 2 at the start of the language portion of the program.

Entry requirements

Students must provide transcripts & graduation documents. They must also meet all other entry requirements of the post-secondary institution.

Start dates

January 4th, March 29th, June 28th, & September 20th (2010).

Study permit

Students must obtain a Study Permit prior to coming to Canada.

Student Support

Students will receive:

- Coaching to acquire the language level and academic skills needed
- Information on what Eurocentres level / IELTS / TOEFL score is needed for the intended course of study
- Personal support and advice to set academic goals
- Help in organizing the required supporting documentation and references
- Assistance with the application process
- Follow up with universities/colleges on the progress of the application

When ready, our team will assist students in the application process and obtain the "Conditional Letter of Acceptance", providing all documentation and requirements have been fulfilled by the student. If necessary, during the time of booking their program with Eurocentres, a test will be administered and the student will choose an appropriate post secondary institution.
